## Nutrition

The Nutrition Programs, Student Lunch Program will run Monday – Thursday weekly. A different lunch item will be offered daily some being hot and some being cold. The menu for lunches will be posted monthly. Lunches will only be offered thru a purchased lunch card, which must be purchased a day in advance of the student needing the lunch with No exceptions.

This is to allow for adequate numbers required for lunch preparation. If you have purchased a lunch card and you know your child will not be staying for lunch that day please inform the school. We prepare lunch for all students everyday who have a lunch card, if they do not show up the lunches are then wasted.

Cost of lunch cards is as follows: \$30.00 Lunch Card -11 lunches which include lunch, a drink (milk, water or juice) and dessert of the day. \$20.00 Lunch Card- 11 lunches which is lunch of the day only. Lunch Cards can be purchased by cash only from Ms. Shukin, Nutrition Coordinator

When new cards are needed to be purchased, a notice will go home with your child when they have only 2 remaining lunches left. This will allow another card to be purchased with a day in advance of the student needing lunch.
